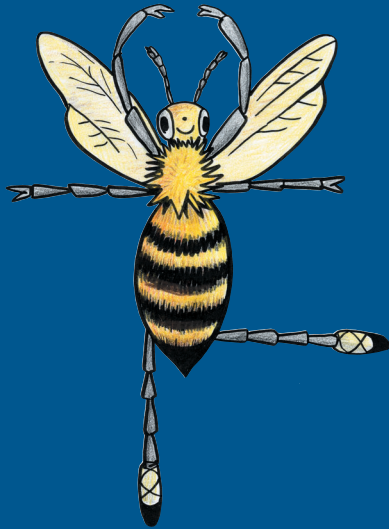


Bee Boogie



When a bee sees a flower, it wants to dance. Bees use "dancing" as a way to talk to other bees instead of using words. A bee's dance tells other bees where the flowers are located.

Bees also use scent to send messages. They give off a special smell, which tells other bees that "I am a member of your hive."



Waggle Dance

The waggle dance tells the other bees that there is a flower far away. The dance shows the bees which direction to fly and how far away the flower is.



Round Dance

The round dance means that there is a flower near the hive. The dance tells the bees to circle the hive until they find the flower.
